

STUDENTS VISIT ECU'S CYBER SECURITY CENTRE

At the end of last term, IIBT's Year 11 Certificate IV in Information Technology students visited the Cyber Security Centre facility at Edith Cowan University (ECU) Joondalup.

This is a \$50 million cooperative research centre (CRC) enabling Western Australia to be the new hub for cyber security research and related education.

IIBT's Certificate IV in Information Technology is a foundation course that enables students to gain basic skills in IT and Information Security.

The Certificate IV in IT leads to IIBT's Diploma of IT which is equivalent to the first year of a bachelor degree, covering subjects such as Cyber Security, Software Engineering and Information Technology.

On successful completion of the Diploma, students receive entry into ECU's bachelor degree qualification.

DIPLOMA OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

The Diploma of IT is equivalent to first year university, covering subjects such as Cyber Security, Software Engineering and Information Technology.

On successful completion students receive entry into 2nd year at ECU:

- Bachelor of Information Technology
- Bachelor of Science (Cyber Security)
- Bachelor of Computing

Graduates of the Diploma of IT may typically work as IT analysts, support technicians, administrators, programmers and managers.

This course provides opportunities for students to appreciate the latest trends in Information Technology and to develop as lifelong learners who continue to update their knowledge and skills alongside their chosen career path.
