IIBT graduate attributes are the skills, attitudes, understandings, and qualities that students should develop during their enrolment with IIBT and be able to demonstrate by the time they graduate. These attributes will help students to become effective and successful global citizens.

At the end of the course, IIBT graduates should be able to demonstrate the following attributes:
